



PawsCo Animal Medication Tracking

Under PACFA regulations, fosters with animals on medication are required to keep a medical tracking log of any medications the animal is taking. Because your foster animal may need to be spay/neutered, dewormed or have a medical condition requiring medication, we ask that you use the attached form to track when you give your animal medication. It is important for PawsCo to comply with this legal requirement so that we can continue operating and saving more lives.

When you finish administering the medication, or when your animal is adopted, please email a copy of this form to Vet Care Team (vet@pawscoadoptions.org). As always, you can reach out to Vet Care Team with questions about this form or about the medical care of your animal.
